Mission Statement

As a duly chartered Team (#4628) of REACT international, a 501 (c) (3) tax exempt, non-profit organization, the purpose for which the team is organized, are charitable, educational and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, include the following;

To develop the use of Citizens Band (CB), Amateur Radio (Ham), General Mobile Radio Service (GMRS), Family Radio Service (FRS) and Multi Use Radio Service (MURS) systems as an additional source of auxiliary communications for emergencies, disasters, motorist aid and charity public service event communications.

To develop and establish a twenty-four (24) hour volunteer monitoring of emergency calls, particularly from officially FCC designated two-way radio emergency channels in the Citizens Band, Amateur Radio Bands and General Mobile Radio Service band services in compliance with all FCC rules and regulations and reporting such calls to appropriate public safety officials.

To develop, administer and coordinate efforts with and provide auxiliary communications assistance for other groups such as but not limited to, local, county, state and or federal Emergency Management Agencies, the American Red Cross, Salvation Army and other public safety authorities or charitable organizations active in disaster relief efforts.

To develop, administer and coordinate public information projects and public service events demonstrating and publicizing the potential benefits and proper use of these (CB, HAM, GMRS, FRS, MURS) radio services to individuals, organizations, industry, local, county, state and federal governments

To engage in community awareness and prevention programs to help the public avoid, detect, and report emergencies effectively. To promote prevention of and protection from events that could endanger the safety of the general public from significant danger, injury/harm, or damage, such as crimes or disasters (natural and/or man-made)
